PREVENTING SLIPS, TRIPS AND FALLS AT WORK

Prevent

- Make sure lighting is bright enough to see properly.
- Secure all cable on ground.
- Mark walkway slopes and changes of levels.
- Ensure footwear has proper tread.

Keep Jobsite Clean & Clear

- Keep area clean and dry (as possible).
- Clean up any spills.
- Keep walkways clear of clutter and obstacles.
- Clear snow and ice from walkways.

Watch Out

- Watch for holes, cracks, or uneven rough areas
- Take extra care on steps, concrete & roofs
- Be aware of icy and snowy conditions
